

## Special Needs Plans (SNP)

The Plan has available a Special Needs Plan (SNP) that has been developed for member's who elect to select a special plan developed for them that provides a specialized benefit structure that would assist the member in the management of their disease. The following are the Special Needs Plans developed:

- Combined Plan for Diabetes, Cardiovascular Disease and Congestive Heart Failure
- Pulmonary Disease
- Dual Eligible Plan ( for members with Medicare and Medicaid benefits)

Enrollment in to the SNP is determined at the time a member enrolls and elects to become a member of one of these special benefit plans. They must complete a Pre-Enrollment questionnaire on which they state they have one of the disease mentioned above. This diagnosis must then be confirmed by the member's physician.

All member's who are enrolled into a SNP are enrolled into the SNP Case Management Program where all receive ongoing management and evaluation with the use of Care plans and physician, member and caregiver involvement in order to reach the goals and outcomes that have been developed.

The SNP Case Management Program is on a voluntary basis for the member who may elect to receive case management services or not.
